Purpose

The BDC shall review, advise and make recommendations to the Board and the Department regarding: land development/building industry matters; the annual budget of County departments with land development/building regulatory functions; the methodology for establishing and the level of all fees charged; land development/building regulatory programs, processes, plans, and procedures for efficiency and effectiveness, etc. The BDC shall assist, advise, and make recommendations to the Department as needed. The BDC shall organize and administer subcommittees for the licensing of certain construction trades as required by law.

Qualifications

The BDC shall be composed of persons who are qualified, by experience and training, to consider and determine matters pertaining to building construction and who are residents of Mecklenburg County. The BDC shall consist of one representative recommended by each of the following organizations and appointed by the Board: Master Electrical Contractors Assoc. of N.C. or Charlotte (MECA); Professional Engineers of North Charlotte (PENC); American Society of Landscape Architects (ASLA); Charlotte Heating & Air Conditioning Contractors Assoc. (HAC); American Institute of Architects (AIA); Mecklenburg General Contractor's Assoc. (MGCA); Charlotte Chamber of Commerce (CCham); Home Builders Assoc. of Charlotte (HBA); Charlotte Plumbing, Heating and Cooling Contractors Assoc. (PHC); Charlotte Apartment Assoc. (CAA); National Association of Remodeling Industry (NARI); Two General Public Members (GP). Representation of the above organizations on the BDC is not limited or restricted to membership in the organizations. All applications from those interested in serving on the BDC shall be provided to the Board for its consideration. Must be a resident of Mecklenburg County.

The Chairperson is appointed by the Board and shall be the Charlotte Chamber of Commerce representative.

Special Notes

Two (2) appointments:

One (1) appointment to fill an unexpired term expiring July 31, 2014 (General Public (GP) representative). The General Public positions were added to represent the average citizen and not persons closely related to or working in the design and construction industry. The desire is that general public representatives would look at consumer problems from the perspective of a homeowner resident or a novice business owner. One (1) appointment for a three-year term expiring July 31, 2016 (American Institute of Architects (AIA) representative).
