Purpose

The Fire Commission's duties and responsibilities are to make regular inspections of each volunteer fire department, at least once annually, to determine whether the department is meeting the minimum standards as specified by the North Carolina Fire Insurance Rating Bureau.

Qualifications

Appointments are made for three-year terms with no one serving more than two consecutive terms. All members are to be active volunteer firemen. Must be a resident of Mecklenburg County.


