Dear Mr. Shields:

At their meeting on Monday, June 10, the Charlotte City Council approved an increase in the Storm Water fee for the minor system inside the City. Effective July 1, 2013, the new monthly Storm Water rates for the City's portion of the Storm Water fee are as follows:

- a. \$5.36 per month for detached single-family properties with less than 2,000 square feet of impervious area.
- b. \$7.89 per month for detached single-family properties with 2,000 or more square feet of impervious area.
- c. \$131.56 per month for non-single-family properties. Rate will be applied to each acre of impervious area and a prorated share of each portion thereof.

In accordance with the Interlocal Agreement entitled "AGREEMENT FOR THE OPERATION OF A SINGLE STORM WATER SYSTEM IN MECKLENBURG COUNTY," we request the Mecklenburg County Board of County Commissioners approve the change in the minor system component of the service charge levied within the City. The change would be pursuant to the amounts listed above.
