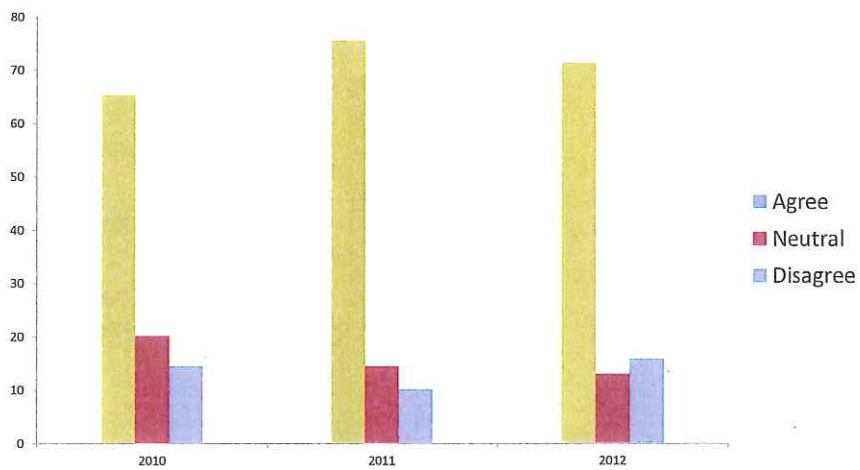

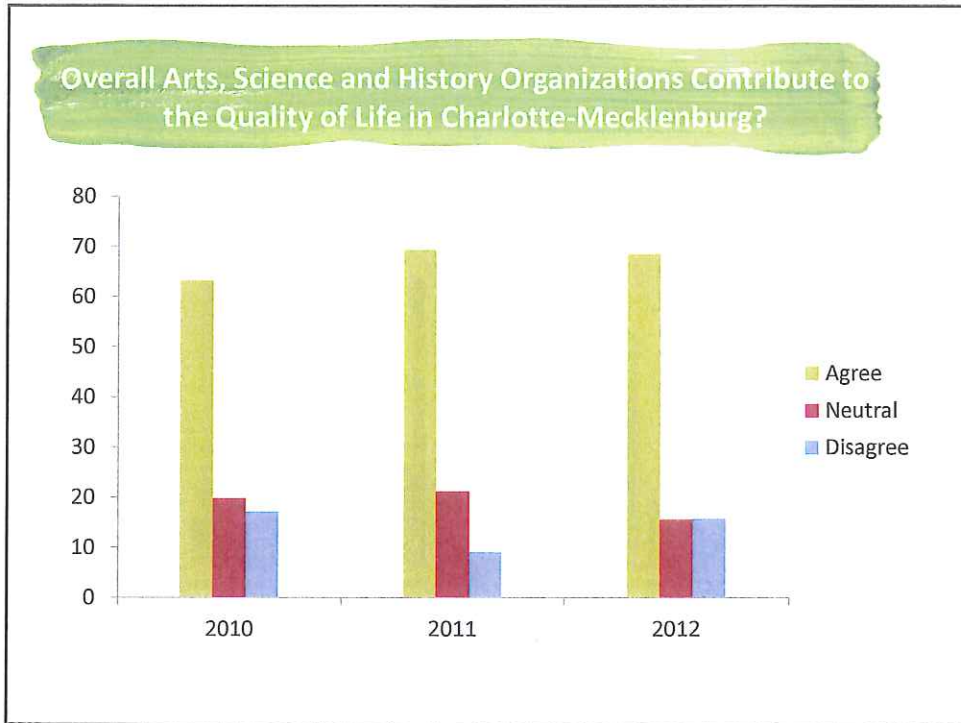


Do you Support Local Government Funding for Arts, Science, or History Facilities?



Arts, Science, History Organizations and Programming make Charlotte-Mecklenburg More Attractive to Businesses and Individuals Considering Relocation

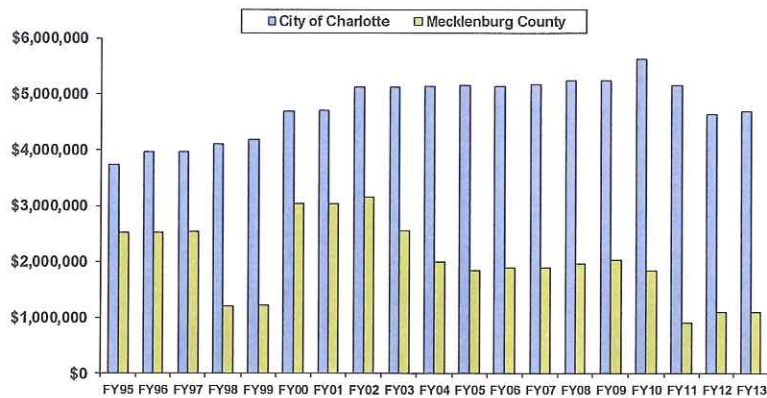

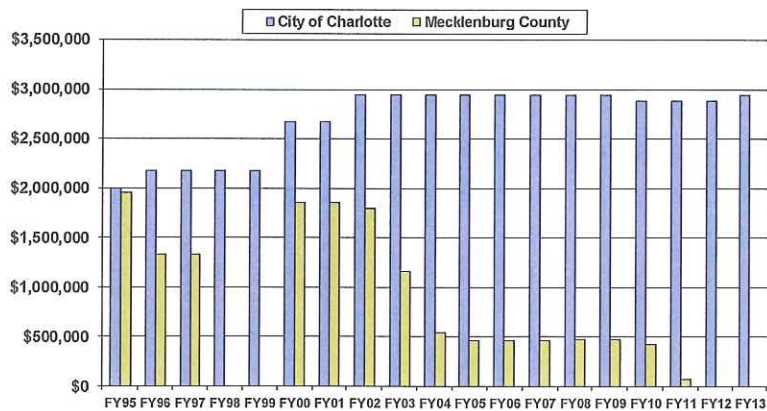
Local Government Funding Track Record

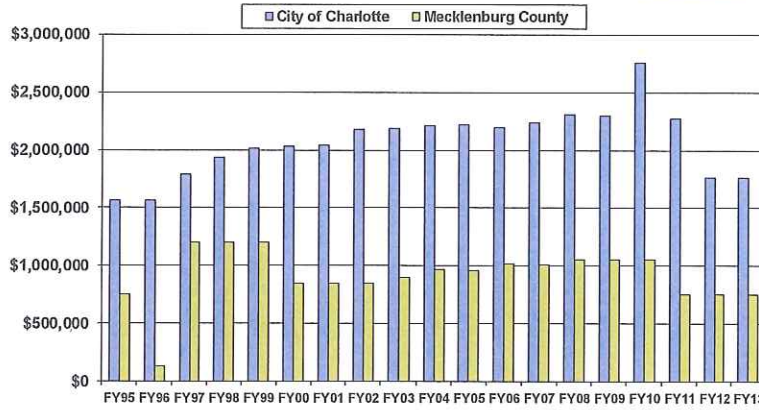
Local Government Funding Track Record
