

Persons serving must be a resident of Mecklenburg County. Appointed members must attend a minimum of 65% of all scheduled meetings in a calendar year and cannot miss three consecutive meetings. Failure to comply with attendance requirements will result in removal from the advisory board. Persons must attend 50% of each meeting in order to be counted present. Appointees must take an oath of office.

### **Advisory Board Details**

The Planning Commission is a jointly appointed Board, administered by the City of Charlotte. There are 14 members on the Commission; the Board of County Commissioners appoints seven (7) members, the City of Charlotte City Council appoints five (5) members, and the Mayor appoints two (2) members. The Board of Education has two (2) positions to which they make recommendations, but with approval of one position by the Board of County Commissioners and the approval of one by the Charlotte City Council respectively. Members of the Planning Commission will be assigned to serve on either subcommittee; the Planning Committee or Zoning Committee.
