CHARLOTTE MECKLENBURG COALITION FOR HOUSING (12 Members)

Membership – The Community based board to implement the Ten Year Plan to End and Prevent Homelessness was approved by City Council at their May 24, 2010 meeting.

Mayor shall appoint the first Chair who shall serve as Chair for three years. Appointment of Chair shall rotate between City, County and Foundation For The Carolinas.

City Council shall appoint representatives of the general community, affordable housing, donors, financial, real estate and legal communities. Mayor shall appoint representative of non-profit, corporate/economic development and faith-based groups. County shall appoint representative s of public safety, education and human services. Ex-officio members shall be the Neighborhood and Business Services Director (City), Community Support Services Director (County) and Charlotte Housing Authority CEO.

Responsibilities – Principal functions of the Board are to ensure implementation of the Ten Year Plan, which is mandated by HUD. Goals include facilitating safe and permanent housing for homeless families and individuals, encouraging intensive outreach and engagement and promoting housing stability for those most at risk of becoming homeless.

Purpose

“Community based board to implement the 10-Year Plan to End and Prevent Homelessness”

Implementation Goals

1. **Housing:** Get homeless families and individuals into appropriate and safe permanent housing as soon as possible;
2. **Outreach and Engagement:** Link chronic homeless to housing, treatment and services through intensive outreach and engagement; and
3. **Prevention:** Promote housing stability for those families and individuals most at risk of becoming homeless
