GRANT PROJECT ORDINANCE

- WHEREAS, Mecklenburg County is applying and/or has been awarded a grant from the Governor's Institute for Suicide Prevention for North Carolina Statewide Suicide Prevention. The grant has been made available to Mecklenburg County under the Governor and Mayor's Suicide Challenge to Prevent and Reduce Suicide Among Transitioning Service Members, Veterans, and their Families Marketing Campaign grant program for up to the amount of \$5,000.00; and
- **WHEREAS,** the grant funds must be used to market a North Carolina Statewide Suicide Prevention program by developing and providing marketing tools, outreach can increase to local and state leaders.
- **WHEREAS**, the Mecklenburg County Board of County Commissioners deems this activity to be a worthy and desirable undertaking;

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO N.C.G.S. 159-13.2, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MECKLENBURG COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS that:

- Section 1. The project described in the Governor and Mayor's Suicide Challenge to Prevent and Reduce Suicide Among Transitioning Service Members, Veterans, and their Families Marketing Campaign grant application is hereby authorized to be undertaken for the duration of the grant.
- Section 2. The County Manager is authorized to execute the grant agreement and other documents that are required or appropriated for the County to receive the Governor and Mayor's Suicide Challenge to Prevent and Reduce Suicide Among Transitioning Service Members, Veterans, and their Families Marketing Campaign and to undertake the project. The County Manager is directed to take steps necessary to ensure compliance with all spending and reporting requirements to the Governor's Institute for Suicide Prevention for North Carolina Statewide Suicide Prevention.
- Section 3. The following revenues are anticipated for Mecklenburg County in the fund G001 to complete this project:
