The report "Clearing the Air in the Historic West End" was used to educate Mecklenburg County Commissioners which resulted in a Federal EPA monitoring station being installed in The Historic West End to measure particle pollution levels. The AQC shall provide citizen and stakeholder input to the Board of County Commissioners, local municipalities and staff through the review and recommendation of air pollution management policies, long-range plans, operations and their budgetary impacts in order to achieve the above mission.
