GRANT PROJECT ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, Mecklenburg County has been awarded a grant from the U.S. Department of Justice. The grant has been made available to Mecklenburg County under the 2021 BJA FY21 Second Chance Act grant as a sub-award through FHI 360 in the amount of \$153,659; and

WHEREAS, the grant funds must be used by state and local governments to support a broad range of activities to prevent and control crime and to improve the criminal justice system; and

WHEREAS, the Mecklenburg County Board of County Commissioners deems this activity to be a worthy and desirable undertaking;

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO N.C.G.S. 159-13.2, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MECKLENBURG COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS that:

- Section 1. The project described by the U.S. Department of Justice is hereby authorized to be undertaken for the duration of the grant.
- Section 2. The County Manager is authorized to execute the grant agreement and other documents that are required or appropriate for the County to receive the BJA FY21 Second Chance Act grant and to undertake the project. The County Manager is directed to take steps necessary to ensure compliance with all spending and reporting requirements of the U.S. Department of Justice.
- Section 3. The following revenues are anticipated for Mecklenburg County in the General Grants Fund to complete this project:
