NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Bond Order Authorizing the Issuance of Not to Exceed \$45,000,000 General Obligation Solid Waste bonds of the County of Mecklenburg, North Carolina WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Mecklenburg, North Carolina (the "County") deems it advisable to make the improvements hereinafter deed the county of Mecklenburg of Mec

WHEREAS, an application has been filed with the Secretary of the Local Government Commission of North Carolina requesting Commission approval of the bonds hereinafter described as required by the Local Government Bond Act, and the Secretary of the Local Government Commission has notified the Board of Commissioners that the application has been accepted for submission to the Local Government Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Board of Commissioners of the County, as follows:

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners of the County has ascertained and hereby determines that it is necessary to provide the funds for additions and capital improvements to, or the acquisition, renewal or replacement of capital assets of, or purchasing and installing of new equipment relating to the operation and maintenance of certain Solid Waste facilities located in the County, including the acquisition of land or rights-of-way in land required therefor.

Section 2. To raise the money required for the purposes described above, in addition to funds which may be available for such purpose from any other source, bonds of the County are hereby authorized and shall be issued pursuant to the Local Government Bond Act of North Carolina. The maximum aggregate principal amount of such bonds authorized by this bond order shall be and not

Taxes will be levied in an amount sufficient to pay the principal and interest of the bonds authorized by this bond order

Section 4. A sworn statement of the County's debt has been filed with the Clerk to the Board of Commissioners and is open to public inspection.

No debt shall be contracted during any fiscal year by the issu-Section 5. No occurrence contracted couring any inscal year by the issuance of bonds pursuant to this bond order if the amount of such debt and if all other debt contracted during such fiscal year shall exceed two-thirds (2/3rds) of the amount by which the outstanding indebtedness of the County shall have been reduced during the next preceding fiscal year, unless the incurring of such debt shall be submitted to a vote of the people of the County and shall be appropried by a parietty of these who wate theorem. proved by a majority of those who vote thereon.

Section 6. This bond order will take effect thirty (30) days after its publica-tion following adoption, unless it is petitioned to a vote of the people within thirty (30) days after its publication as introduced, as provided in N. C. G. S. Section 159-60, and in that event the order will take effect when approved by the voters

The foregoing bond order has been introduced and a swom statement of debt has been filled under the Local Government Bond Act showing the appraised value of the County of Mecklenburg, North Carolina to be \$29.361, 459.927 and the net debt thereof, including the proposed bonds, to be \$4,033,545,000. The Chief Financial Officer of the County has filled a statement estimating that the total amount of interest that will be paid on the bonds over the expected term of the bonds, if issued, is \$25,250,400. A tax is authorized to be levied to pay the principal and and interest on the bonds if they are issued. The Chief Financial Officer has filled a statement estimating that no proposed bonds. These estimates are preliminary, are for general informational purposes only, and may differ from the actual interest paid on the bonds or the actual property tax increases required to provide sufficient funds to pay the principal and interest on the bonds or the actual property tax increases required to provide sufficient funds to pay the principal and interest on the bonds.

Aryone who wishes to be heard on the questions of the validity of the bond order and the advisability of issuing the bonds may appear at a public hearing or an adjournment thereof to be held at the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Government Center Meeting Chamber, 600 East Fourth Street, Charlotte, NC, 28020 at 6:30 p.m., or as soon thereafter as practicable, on the 3rd day of December, 2024. The deadline to register online is 3:00 p.m. the day of the meeting, but persons desiring to speak can also sign up to speak at the meeting, but on the start of the public hearing. 
