- Gwen Cook presented a naming opportunity for urban Little Sugar Creek Greenway. Park and Recreation is recommending that the circular lawn and garden area adjacent to the Spirit of Mecklenburg sculpture (Captain James Jack on horseback) between Elizabeth Avenue and East 4th Street be named Zeiss Green on Little Sugar Creek Greenway in honor of Dr. Tony Zeiss, president of Central Piedmont Community College. Dr. Zeiss has passionately led the Little Sugar Creek Greenway for over 12 years. He also chairs the Trail of History Committee, a proposed collection of bronze sculptures depicting Mecklenburg history. His commitment Little Sugar Creek Greenway & Stream Restoration, the larger community, local history and education can be recognized in this tangible way. A motion was made to approve the recommendation and send it forward to the Park and Recreation Commission and the Board of County Commissioners. The motion was unanimously approved
