WHEREAS, the observance of Ramadan serves as a reminder of the importance of faith, community, and service in our lives, and encourages us to strive for peace, justice, and equality for all people; and

WHEREAS, we urge all people to embrace the values of compassion, empathy, and charity that are emphasized during this holy month, and to strive for a world where all people are treated with dignity and respect.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the County of Mecklenburg acknowledges the importance of Ramadan as a time of spiritual growth, reflection, devotion, and inspiration to work towards a more just and compassionate world for all and declares that the County of Mecklenburg recognizes March 10th to April 8th as
