MECKLENBURG COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS RESOLUTION ON DONATION OF EQUIPMENT TO CENTRAL PIEDMONT COMMUNITY COLLEGE

WHEREAS, the Mecklenburg County Sheriff's Office has six (6) high mileage vehicles which have been scheduled to be decommissioned; and

WHEREAS, the high mileage vehicles are three (3) 2014 Dodge Charger vehicles, one (1) 2017 Dodge Charger vehicle, two (2) 2018 Dodge Charger vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the Mecklenburg County Sheriff has learned that the Central Piedmont Community College-BLET Program is in need of such vehicles; and

WHEREAS, NCGS 160A-280 allows one North Carolina local government to donate obsolete or unused personal property to another governmental unit within the United States; and

WHEREAS, as required by law a notice has been posted at least 5 days prior to the February 20, 2024 Board of County Commissioners meeting indicating that the Board of Commissioners would consider donating the high mileage vehicles to the Central Piedmont Community College; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Mecklenburg County Board of Commissioners does hereby approve donating the six (6) high mileage vehicles and authorizes the County Manager, or his designee, to take all necessary actions to convey title to such equipment to the Central Piedmont Community College.
