

Do you need help paying your heating bill this winter?

Mecklenburg County is offering help to residents this winter by providing Low Income Energy Assistance Program (LIEAP) funds to eligible households. LIEAP is a federal program that assists low-income households with their immediate heating needs, so they won't have to choose between heating their homes and buying other necessities.

You do not have to be at risk of disconnection or delinquent to take advantage of this one-time, direct vendor payment in the amount of \$300, \$400, or \$500.

WHEN DO LAPPLY?

- December March (Seniors 60+)
- January March (All Households)

HOW DO I APPLY?

HOUSEHOLD CRITERIA

- · At least one eligible U.S. Citizen or Legal Resident
- · Be responsible for the heating cost
- Income at or below 130% of the Federal Poverty Limit (Individuals under age 60)
- Income at or below 150% of the Federal Poverty Limit (Individuals age 60 or over)
- Households DO NOT have to be behind on their energy bill to qualify.

WHAT FORMS OF VERIFICATIONS ARE REQUIRED?

- Any of the following forms of identification: State ID Card, Driver's License or Passport
- · Utility Bill
- Social Security Number
- Proof of Income

LIEAP PAYMENT DETAILS:

Checks will be sent directly to the utility companies/vendors. The amount of the payment is based on the household's source of fuel (e.g., electric, gas, etc.) and other criteria. For more information, please visit our county website:
