Purpose

The Planning Commission was established to make studies of resources, possibilities and needs of the City, particularly with respect to conditions which may be injurious to the public welfare and make plans for the development of Mecklenburg County, including the City of Charlotte but excluding all other incorporated towns in the County. To consider the desirability, from time to time, of the extension of the limits of Charlotte and when found desirable, to prepare and present to Council a program of extension with statement of the reasons for the same. Appointments are made for three-year terms with no one serving more than two consecutive full terms. The Board appointments will be the following: six (6) by the BOCC, six (6) by the City Council and two (2) by the Board of Education but with approval of the BOCC and City Council respectively.

Qualifications

Must be a resident of Mecklenburg County.

Special Notes

Three (3) appointments for a three-year term expiring June 30, 2015.

Deborah Ryan, Dwayne Walker and Andrew Zoutewelle are all eligible for reappointment.


