








ETJ Top Five

based on final call type by Type






2023 Huntersville Police Department Citizen Initiated Calls Only Response Time: 911 Pickup to Arrived on Scene

The data used to determine these times was limited to records where the agency type was Police, the time the primary unit assigned was populated, the time the unit arrived was populated, total service time was not null, and citizen-initiated calls only. The following call dispositions were excluded from analysis: cancelled, advised event (BOLO), 911 hang-ups, and officer-initiated calls. The original priority level was used in this analysis instead of final priority level which could skew results. Additionally, the standard deviation was calculated using the above parameters by priority. Calls which had 0 or null response time as well as calls that were two standard deviations above the average were identified as outliers and excluded (90 calls total). 


