

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING REGARDING
EXEMPT FACILITIES REVENUE BONDS TO BE ISSUED
BY THE MECKLENBURG COUNTY INDUSTRIAL FACILITIES
AND POLLUTION CONTROL FINANCING AUTHORITY

Notice is hereby given that the Board of Commissioners of Mecklenburg County, North Carolina (the "County") will hold a public hearing on _____, 2026, at ____ [a.m./p.m.] (or as soon thereafter as it may be heard), in the Meeting Chamber Conference Room CH-14 of the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Government Center located at 600 East Fourth Street, Charlotte, North Carolina, concerning the proposed issuance and sale by The Mecklenburg County Industrial Facilities and Pollution Control Financing Authority (the "Authority") of its tax-exempt and taxable revenue bonds (the "Bonds") in an amount not to exceed \$[20,000,000]. A portion of the Bonds in an amount not to exceed \$_____ is expected to be issued as tax-exempt, exempt facility bonds, the proceeds of which will be used to finance a "solid waste disposal facility," as defined in Section 142(a)(6) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code").

Greenway Waste Solutions, LLC, a North Carolina limited liability company, or an affiliated or related entity (the "Company") is considering the expansion, renovation and improvement of its existing solid waste disposal facility located at 15300 Holbrooks Road in Huntersville, Mecklenburg County, North Carolina, along with related site work and improvements (collectively, the "Project"). The proceeds of the Bonds would be loaned to the Company and used to, among other things, finance certain costs of the Project. The Project will be owned and operated by the Company.

The Bonds, when and if issued by the Authority, will be issued pursuant to Chapter 159C of the General Statutes of North Carolina and shall not be a debt of the State of North Carolina (the "State") or any political subdivision or any agency thereof, including the Authority and the County, or a pledge of the faith and credit of the State or any political subdivision or any such agency, including the Authority and the County, but shall be payable solely from the revenues and other funds derived solely from payments made by the Company.

Any person interested in the issuance of the Bonds or the location or nature of the Project may appear and be heard. Any person who wishes to make comments in writing on the proposed issuance of the Bonds or the Project may do so, within fourteen (14) days, to The Mecklenburg County Industrial Facilities and Pollution Control Financing Authority and the Board of Commissioners of Mecklenburg County, c/o Clerk to the Board of Commissioners, 600 East Fourth Street, Charlotte, North Carolina 28202.
