(PHC) two persons: One person from a business primarily involved in Mechanical/HVAC trade work and One person from a business primarily involved in Plumbing trade work; Greater Charlotte Apartment Assoc. (GCAA); National Association of Remodeling Industry (NARI); Two General Public Members (GP); Associated Builder and Contractors (ABC) Carolina Chapter represented by a person employed by a firm with an NC General Contractor's license and primarily involved in general construction. The Chairperson is appointed by the Board and shall be the Charlotte Chamber of Commerce representative.
