

GRANT PROJECT ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, Mecklenburg County has been awarded a grant from the National Association of County and City Health Officials (NACCHO). The grant has been made available to Mecklenburg County under the Pediatric Vaccination Coverage through Partnerships with Early Care and Education Programs grant up to the amount of \$120,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the grant funds must be used to towards pediatric vaccination education, child care center vaccine champions and communications campaign promoting pediatric vaccinations in zip codes with the lowest pediatric vaccination rates.

WHEREAS, the Mecklenburg County Board of County Commissioners deems this activity to be a worthy and desirable undertaking;

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO N.C.G.S. 159-13.2, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MECKLENBURG COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS that:

Section 1. The project described in the **National Association of County and City Health Officials** grant application is hereby authorized to be undertaken for the duration of the grant.

Section 2. The County Manager is authorized to execute the grant agreement and other documents that are required or appropriate for the County to receive the **Pediatric Vaccination Coverage through Partnerships with Early Care and Education Programs grant** and to undertake the project. The County Manager is directed to take steps necessary to ensure compliance with all spending and reporting requirements **National Association of County and City Health Officials**

Section 3. The following revenues are anticipated for Mecklenburg County in the General Grants Fund (G001) to complete this project:
