

# Mecklenburg County Homeless Bookings: Supplemental Analysis

This report identifies and tracks Fiscal Year 2015 offenses associated with 58 pre-determined individuals who are either confirmed as homeless or likely to be homeless. This report was compiled and produced by Mecklenburg County Criminal Justice Services.

#### I. Offense Type

76% of the FY15 offenses associated with these individuals were misdemeanors.

#### II. Violent and Nonviolent Offenses<sup>3</sup>

 90% of all FY15 offenses associated with these individuals were nonviolent, with nearly 70% of all FY15 offenses for these individuals being nonviolent misdemeanors.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>3</sup> The violent/non-violent categorization in table 3 was conducted using the same logic applied during the Safety and Justice Challenge data analysis. Each offense code was categorized as violent or non-violent based on the following definition which originated with Pretrial Services' PSA risk assessment tool: "offenses are considered violent when a person causes or attempts to cause physical injury to another person."

### III. Offense Type and Class<sup>4</sup>

• 41% of all FY15 offenses associated with these individuals were Class 3 misdemeanors.

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<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>4</sup> Percentages in sub-categories (such as those in sections 2 and 3) represent the percentage of the overall charges, not the percentage within the category. For example, Class 3 misdemeanors represent 40.59% of all charges, not 40.59% of all misdemeanor charges. As such, sub-categories will sum to equal the count and percentage of their master category.
