

ETJ Discussion with the City of Charlotte

There are eight items that need to be resolved:

- 1. BOCC still requesting a one-year extension
- 2. Service level commitments in the ETJ and penalties for non-compliance
- 3. Cost control the mechanism of capturing natural growth does not control costs over the long term
- 4. Reporting to the BOCC on a regular basis
- 5. Fulfillment of data request from July
- 6. Commitment that any annexation in the ETJ will not increase cost or taxes to those remaining in the ETJ
- 7. Elimination of general fund subsidy to the ETJ
- 8. Tax inequity for residents that live in the Mint Hill ETJ
