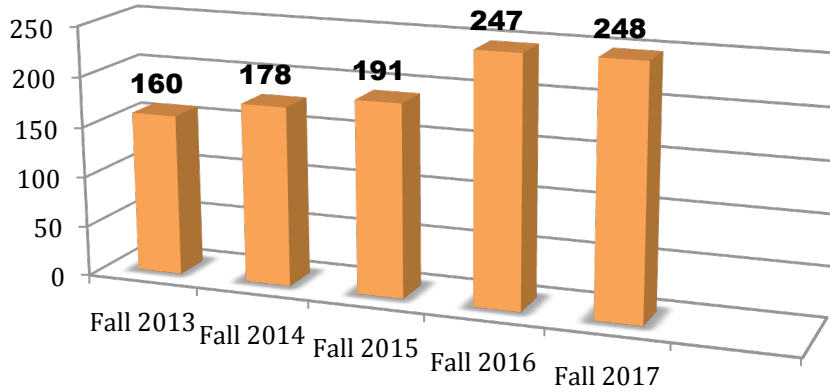

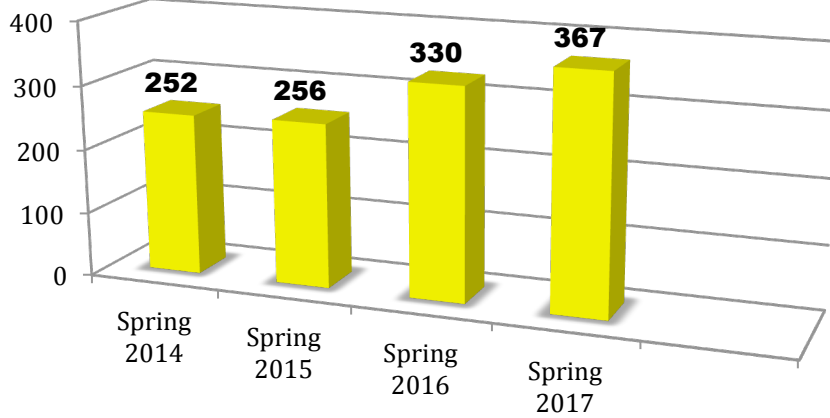

Youth Participation: Fall



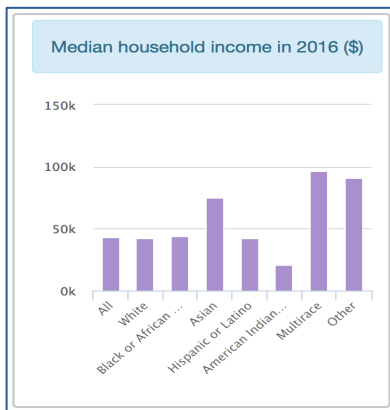
