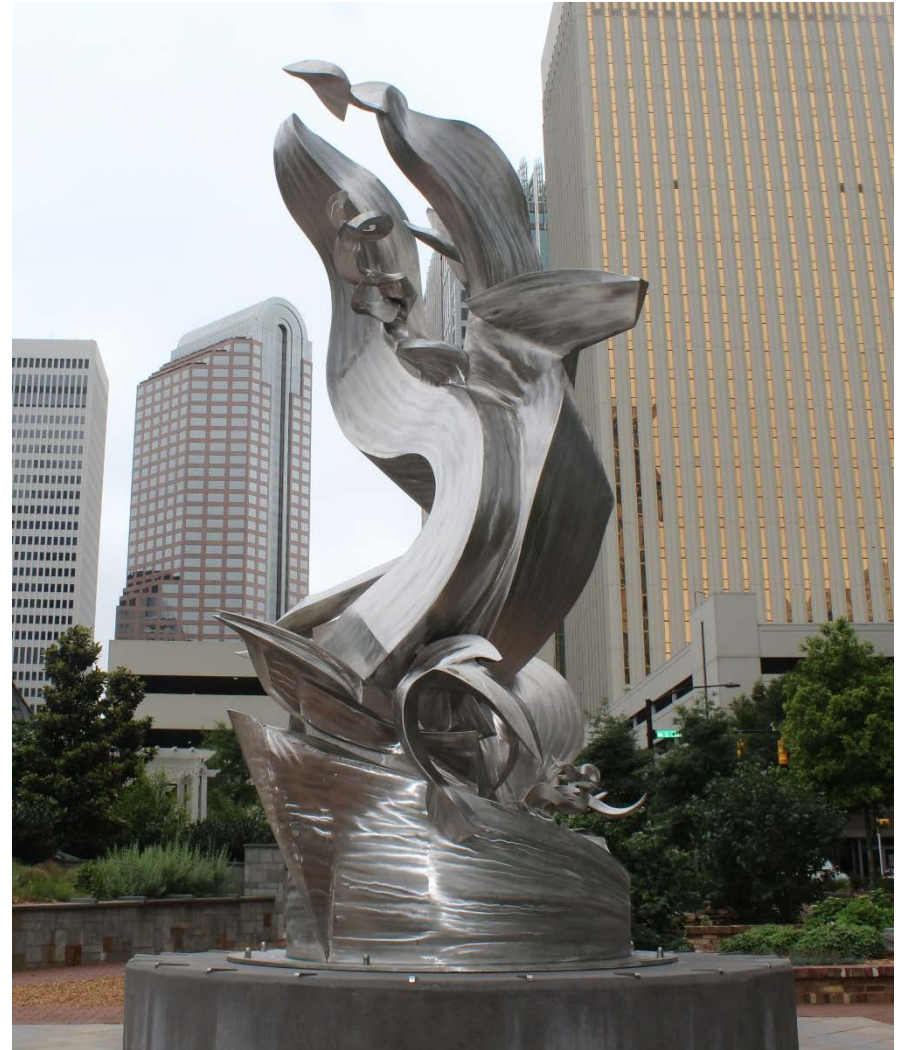


Public Art - Community Capacity Building

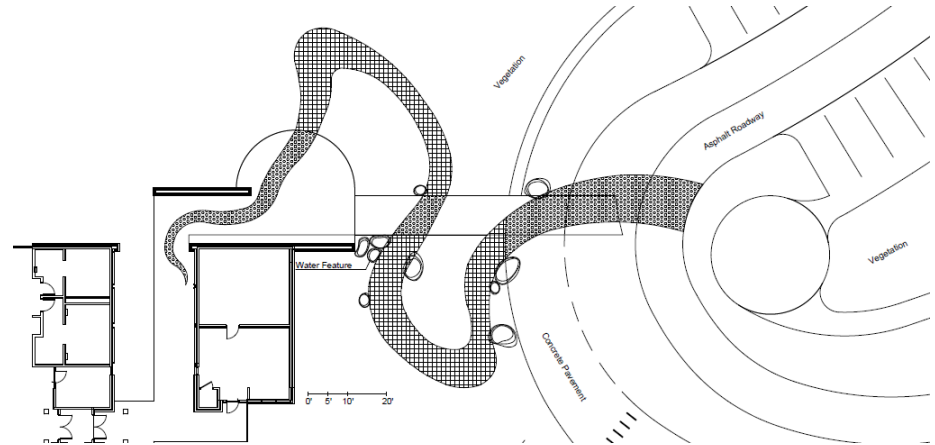

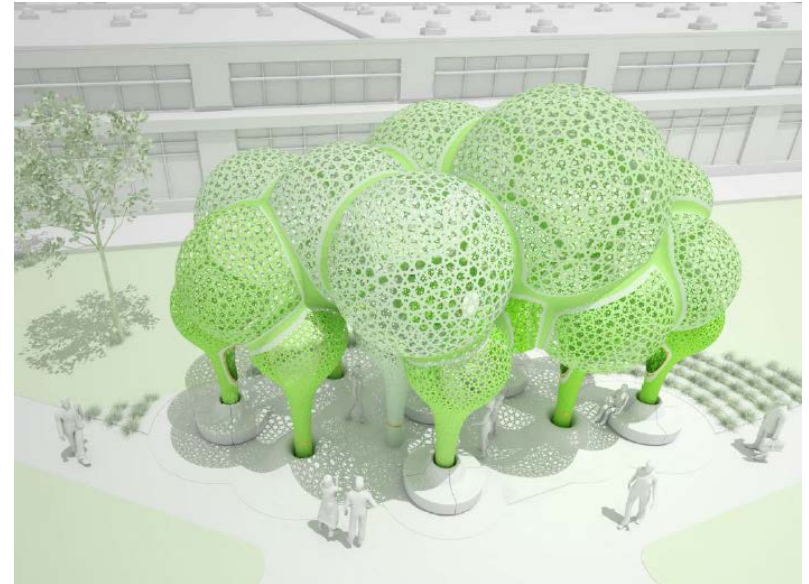
