

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED ABOLISHMENT OF THE CURRENT COUNTY-WIDE MECKLENBURG COUNTY LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICE DISTRICT

Notice is hereby given that the Mecklenburg Board of County Commissioners will hold a public hearing regarding the proposed abolishment of the current County-Wide Law Enforcement Service District covering the unincorporated land use planning areas of the entire County. If abolished, Mecklenburg County would instead have six (6) law enforcement service districts covering the unincorporated land use planning areas of the City of Charlotte; Town of Cornelius; Town of Davidson; Town of Huntersville; Town of Mint Hill and Town of Pineville. Each of the six law enforcement service districts were approved by the Board of County Commissioners at its public hearing on May 1, 2018.
