Purpose

The County hereby appoints the Charlotte/Mecklenburg Public Art Commission as a joint commission of the Board of County Commissioners and the Charlotte City Council to carry out the Public Art ordinance. The Public Art Commission shall be composed of nine (9) members, three (3) appointed by the City Council, three (3) appointed by the Board of County Commissioners, and three (3) appointed by the Board of Directors of ASC. The Public Art Commission may, from time to time, select advisors for particular public art projects in accordance with the size and complexity of the projects. The Public Art Commission shall encourage broad community participation in the public art program, including naming a community representative on artist selection panels. The Public Art Commission shall engage ASC by contract to administer the public art program pursuant to an agreement between the County, the Public Art Commission and ASC. The Public Art Commission shall establish policies and procedures for the operation of the program. The Public Art Commission, assisted by ASC staff, shall annually review the capital projects proposed by the County, including those in the Capital Improvement Program, to determine which are Eligible Projects. Based upon such information, the Public Art Commission shall prepare an annual work plan for approval by the Board of County Commissioners.

Qualifications

The members of the Public Art Commission shall be appointed by the City, the County and the ASC Board, as designated below:

Three from visual arts or design professions (ASC)
Two from the business sector (County 1, City 1)
Two from the education field (County 1, City 1)

Two at-large, community representatives (County 1, City 1)

Must be a resident of Mecklenburg County.
