**QUESTIONNAIRE**  
**APPLICANTS FOR HUNTERSVILLE PLANNING BOARD**

To assist the Huntersville Board of Commissioners in making appointments to the Planning Board, please respond briefly to the following questions. There are no right or wrong answers. Your responses will provide a framework for discussion with the Mayor and Commissioners.

**Overview:** The Planning Board consists of members appointed by the Mayor and Commissioners (for in-town residents) and by the Mecklenburg County Board of Commissioners (for ETJ residents). North Carolina law requires that the composition of the Board represent the relative population of the city limits and the extra-territorial jurisdiction (ETJ). Therefore, the Huntersville Planning Board consists of eight (8) in-town residents and three (3) ETJ residents and acts as an advisory body to the Board of Commissioners on all matters related to the growth and development of Huntersville. The Planning Board considers the facts relative to rezoning applications, new subdivisions and site plans, and ordinance amendments, among other issues. The Board formulates a recommendation on each matter, which in turn goes to the Commissioners for final action. The meetings take place at 7:00 p.m. in Town Hall on the fourth Tuesday of each month.

1. Please describe the areas of community service in which you have participated, in Huntersville or elsewhere.

IN THE PAST, I LED A FUNDRAISER FOR HABITAT WHICH RAISED OVER \$4,000, AND WORKED WITH A TRAINING PROGRAM FOR THE DISABLED THROUGH GOOD WILL. I WAS ACTIVE IN THE STUDY LED BY LAND ETHICS IN HUNTERSVILLE. I HAVE ALSO WORKED TO PRESERVE HISTORIC LANDMARKS IN THE HUNTERSVILLE AREA

MONEY WILL BE THE MAIN OBSTACLE. MONEY WILL BE NEEDED TO DEVELOP ROADS & TRANSIT. MONEY WILL BE NEEDED TO PRESERVE THE OPEN SPACE REQUIRED BY THE ZONING ORDINANCE IF THIS CHANGES. MONEY WILL BE NEEDED FOR PUBLIC OPEN SPACE IN THE FORM OF PARKS AND GREENWAYS. THERE ARE MANY THINGS WHICH THE PEOPLE OF HUNTERSVILLE WILL BE ASKED TO PAY.
