NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN to all interested persons that the Public Finance Authority, a public authority existing under the laws of the State of Wisconsin (the "Authority"), has been requested to issue its Educational Facilities Revenue Bonds (Queens University of Charlotte), in one or more series (the "Bonds"), and to lend the proceeds thereof to Queens University of Charlotte, a North Carolina nonprofit corporation (the "University"), for the following purposes:

(1) to finance the construction and furnishing of a new 120 to 130 bed residence hall on the main campus of the University at the location of an existing administrative office building known as Stultz Hall (to be demolished), the renovation of an existing residence hall known as Bell Residence Hall, and the renovation of existing space on the main campus to house the administrative teams and functions to be relocated from Stultz Hall (collectively, the "Project"); and
(2) to pay certain costs incurred in connection with the issuance of the Bonds.

The maximum principal amount of Bonds proposed to be issued by the Authority is \$15,500,000.

The Project is and will be owned and operated by the University and is or will be located on the University's main campus at 1900 Selwyn Avenue, Charlotte, North Carolina, which campus is bounded by Selwyn Avenue to the east, Wellstar Avenue to the south and Radcliffe Avenue to the north.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of Commissioners of Mecklenburg County will hold a regular meeting in the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Government Center, Meeting Chamber, Lobby Level, 600 East 4th Street, Charlotte, North Carolina at 6:00 p.m. on Tuesday, September 18, 2018. At said meeting, the Board of Commissioners will conduct a public hearing at 6:30 p.m. or as soon as practicable thereafter, concerning the proposed issuance of the Bonds and the nature and location of the Project to be financed thereby and will conduct such other business as may properly come before the Board of Commissioners. At the hearing, the Board of Commissioners will invite comments from the public concerning the issuance of the Bonds by the Authority, the use of proceeds thereof and the nature

and location of the Project. The Board of Commissioners also intends at the meeting to consider and take action on a proposal to approve the issuance of the Bonds by the Authority and to approve in principle the issuance of the Bonds for the purposes of financing the Project.

The public hearing will provide an opportunity for all interested persons to express their views, both orally and in writing, on the proposed issuance of the Bonds and the financing of the Project.

Any person interested in the issuance of the Bonds may appear and be heard or submit written comments.
