- 3) Groundwater Appeals. Hear appeals and reach decisions on : denial, modifications, revocation or issuance of well permits and notices of violations.
- 4. Variances. Hear appeals from the granting or denial or variances by the Director, and grant variances when appropriate.
- 5. Councils, Commissions, and Staff Resource. Respond to the Board of Commissioners and staff requests for advice on matters related to the comprehensive groundwater management program in Mecklenburg County.
- 6. Reporting. Present the Board of Commissioners with an annual report of key actions and issues.
