Must be able to travel to each facility in the county. Be available to serve an average of eight (8) hours per month. Must be able to complete an initial orientation and field training of 15 hours. Must be a resident of Mecklenburg County.

NOMINATIONS/APPOINTMENTS/REAPPOINTMENT NEEDED FOR:

1) Four (4) one-year terms expiring May 30, 2020

The Board can nominate and appoint William Hudson, Kelly McKinnon, Janice Robinson and Sharrone Robinson. This will bring the membership to 26.

2) Reappointment Consideration for Kay Roderick
The Ombudsman for the Nursing Home Community Advisory Committee is requesting the reappointment of Kay Roderick for a three-year term expiring May 30, 2022. Even though she's served the normal term limit, Ms. Roderick's continued service is vital, because she's assisting the Ombudsman with training new members.

Note: The highlighted applicants have been cleared for appointment. The remaining applicants are pending screening by the Ombudsman at the Centralina Council of Governments and will be brought forth at a later date.


