





Marshall Park Can Be Saved!

There is a path forward to save the 5.5 acre Marshall Park and incorporate it into the new Brooklyn Village development. Here's how our County Commissioners can do it:


 Land is precious, especially park land, and if Marshall Park is reduced in size we can never get it back.

 Mecklenburg County owns a valuable 4 acre site that is home to our Aquatic Center at the corner of E. Stonewall St and S. McDowell St. 2 acres of that site is a parking lot.

 The highest and best use of property inside the I-277 loop is no longer single story. The highest and best use is now dense multi-story buildings and in the future that will only increase.

 The Brooklyn Village development is planned in 2 parts – North and South – which will not be connected. The Aquatic Center sits between the 2 sites.

 Mecklenburg Board of County Commissioners and BK Partners have an excellent opportunity to save our 5.5 acre park and ensure the future of our Aquatic Center.

 The County's goal has been to add a 3rd pool to the Aquatic Center. BOCC can negotiate a deal for the Aquatic Center parking lot in which BK Partners can add a building to their development which can include Aquatic Center parking and a third iconic pool. Brooklyn Village will take a dozen or so years to build out. By then the Aquatic Center renovation will be aging and BOCC can also negotiate a deal for BK Partners to build another building to include a new Aquatic Center.

 Then Brooklyn Village North and South would be connected and have a 5.5 acre park for citizens and all of the new residents to enjoy!
