JCPC Authority and Mission

- The Juvenile Crime Prevention Council (JCPC)
 is a statutorily authorized advisory board*
- Mission: to address gaps in youth services by promoting prevention, intervention, treatment, and aftercare strategies and programs that strengthen families and support community safety



*General Statute 143B-845 – 852

JCPC Funding

- The North Carolina Department of Public Safety Division of Adult Corrections and Juvenile Justice allocates annual funding to the JCPC
- For FY20, Mecklenburg County JCPC's original funding allocation was \$1,415,682
- In response to Raise the Age, NCDPS awarded the Mecklenburg County JCPC an additional \$381,715





FY20 Expansion Funds

The JCPC requested proposals for community-based programs targeting delinquent youth and those youth lacking supervision or exhibiting behaviors that present the highest risk of juvenile court involvement with a particular focus on programs with the capacity to serve older youth.
