WHEREAS, in some cases, traffickers trick, defraud or physically force victims into providing commercial sex; in other cases, victims are lied to, assaulted, threatened or manipulated into working under inhumane, illegal or otherwise unacceptable conditions; and

WHEREAS, according to the National Human Trafficking Resource Center, North Carolina is number ten in the United States and has been in the top ten since 2012, and the city of Charlotte is considered the number one destination in North Carolina for trafficking; and

**WHEREAS**, Human Trafficking Awareness Month is a great opportunity for the city of Charlotte and Mecklenburg County to address the issue of sex and labor trafficking in our community; and

WHEREAS, Human Trafficking Awareness Month is a great opportunity to recognize the local programs that provide shelter, programs and services, as well as recognize the individuals advocating for trafficking victims in our community; and

WHEREAS, Human Trafficking Charlotte (HTCharlotte) and all the local programs and services thank the city of Charlotte and Mecklenburg County on making Human Trafficking a priority in 2020:
