1. Carry forward unspent funds from the American Public Health Association (APHA) for Village HeartBEAT being recognized as a Healthiest Cities and Counties Challenge Award recipient that remain unspent at June 30, 2018 in the amount of \$25,000
2. Carry forward unspent County funds for PrEP that remain unspent at June 30, 2018 not to exceed \$232,222
3. Carry forward unspent County funds for Tobacco Cessation that remain unspent at June 30, 2018 estimated to be \$29,676
