#### **BACKGROUND/JUSTIFICATION:**

The NC Legislature approved a position for a new Superior Court Judge in 2021. Because all existing courtrooms in the Mecklenburg County courthouse are assigned, this action will require the upfit of an additional courtroom. The County is obligated by State statute to provide facilities and furniture for the court system. The cost for this will be approximately \$1 million.
