**BACKGROUND/JUSTIFICATION:**

Mecklenburg County Park and Recreation Department is requesting approval to apply for and receive, if awarded, a Health Promotion/Disease Prevention grant for up to \$4,500. The grant awards will be distributed in FY2020 and will be used to continue providing nationally recognized evidenced based HPDP classes at all three Mecklenburg County Park and Recreation Senior Centers, some Recreation Centers and other locations in the community. The required 10% match will be fulfilled with salaries of the staff scheduling and/or teaching these classes. The notice and application was received by the department via email on May
