BACKGROUND/JUSTIFICATION:

This action will increase grant money from the State of North Carolina by \$15,000 to pay the cost of the "Charlotte Air Awareness Program". The grant is being extended by six months from March 31, 2020 to September 30, 2020 and the budget increase is necessary to pay 100% of the costs associated with performing the work outlined in the scope of work during the additional six-month period.

The Charlotte Air Awareness Program partners with the community to improve local air quality by providing outreach and education to residents, businesses and schools on topics including health
