BACKGROUND/JUSTIFICATION:

A Request for Qualifications advertisement was distributed on October 25, 2018.

Advertisements were placed in the following publications: Charlotte Observer Charlotte Post State of North Carolina Interactive Purchasing System Charlotte Region American Institute of Architects

Two (2) firms submitted Qualifications Statements expressing an interest in the project and a desire to be interviewed: RDM Architecture and Angelo Architects.

On November 6, 2018, a shortlist committee composed of staff from the Medical Examiner's Office and Asset and Facility Management determined that both firms should be interviewed for the project.

Per the Board's instructions, the Selection Committee submits the following report:

On February 4, 2019, the Selection Committee interviewed the two (2) interested firms: RDM Architecture and Angelo Architects.

Based on the information presented in the written submittals and at the oral presentations, the Committee recommends Angelo Architects as the top-ranked firm and RDM Architecture as the alternate firm.
