## Title: Lease for ATM Machines at County Facilities

#### BACKGROUND/JUSTIFICATION:

The Finance Department issued a Request for Proposals (RFP) to install, maintain, and operate Automated Teller Machines (ATM) in the County facilities listed below. The RFP was issued because the current ATM provider, Fifth Third Bank, notified the County of their intent to not exercise the option on the existing contract. Two proposals were received in response to the RFP. This action would approve the lease for the North Carolina State Employees Credit Union (SECU) to replace and operate ATM's at the locations listed below. The ATMs will provide convenient locations to access funds for visitors and employees at the facilities.
