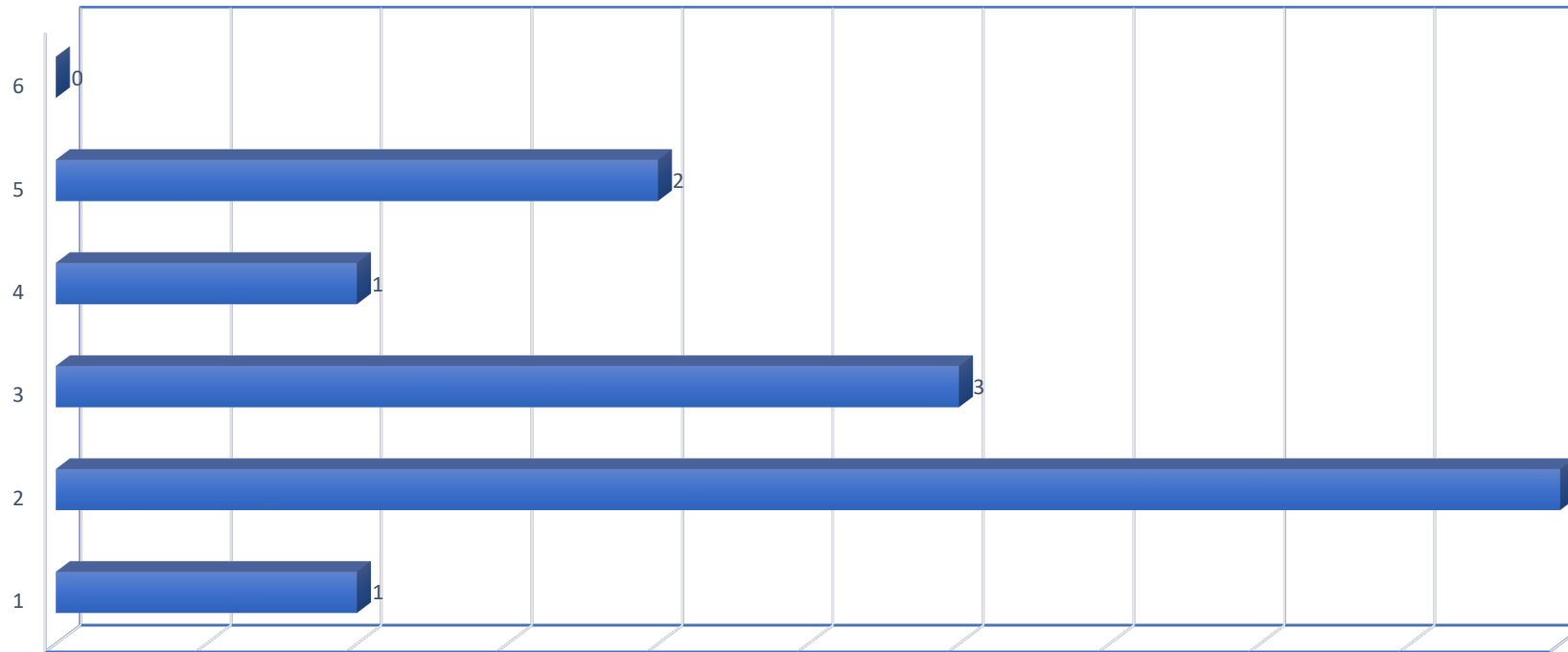

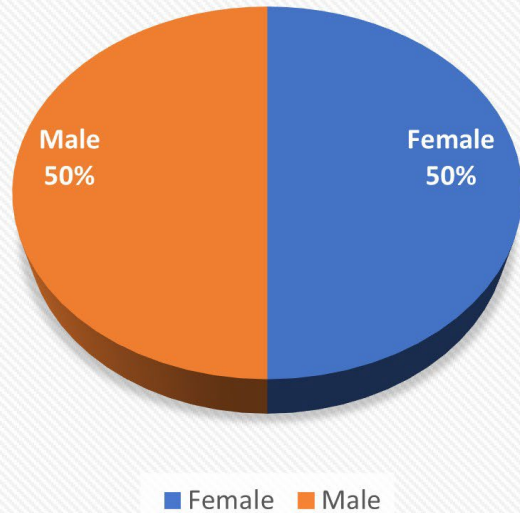
Members by County District



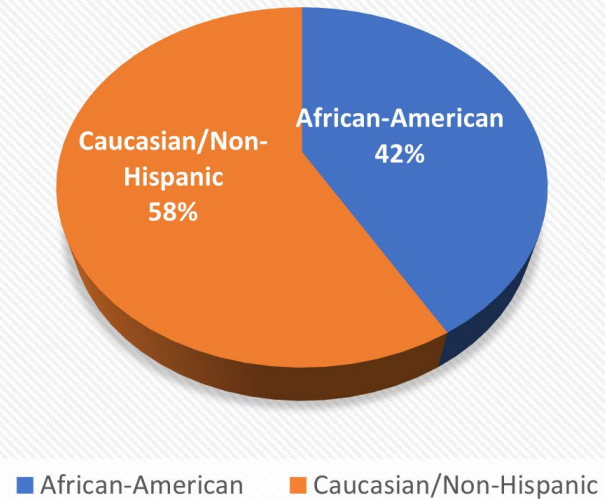
